comes to £ 3262.13.4, and we
are in the course of realizing it,
paying debts, and settling the
debt. In a short time we
will be in a position to
state the share falling to
you. At the same time we would

feel obliged by your informing
us ~~with~~ the names and
addresses of your Brothers
and Sisters alive, if the latter
are married let us also have
those of the Husbands, if
you have Brothers and Sisters
dead having left issue tell
us so, and the names and
ages of the Children -

On our receiving the above
information from you,
we would then be in a
position to send you out
a list of the Estate,
and a discharge for you,
and their signatures for
the exoneration of the Executors.

us how and where to make
the money payable to you
