Dear William;-

Wish I could give complete answers to your Bower-Huntington queries, because if I could that would mean that I have the information myself.

However, such information as I have is yours for the asking, and here is all I can tell you at present.

Joseph Bower, son of William Bower, was born in Williamsburg in 1813. His wife, Mary Ann (Huntington) Bower, was born at Madrid, N.Y., June 20, 1818. They were married in January, 1837 - don't know where for sure, but most probably at Kemptville.

Have no information as to the date of marriage of Ann Bower, sister of Joseph above, to Samuel Huntington. If you later get any information to complete matters in this letter, please pass it on to me. Have not done much work on the Huntington branch yet, because there is published the genealogy of the Huntington family, and I hope to get a lot from that when I want it. Had a fine trip to the west coast, Aug. 14th to Sept. 23rd. In Vancouver saw Uncle Gid, youngest son of Joseph & Mary Ann Bower, also a Mr. B.V. Dunkley, 164 - 14th Ave, West, who has done a lot of work on the Schwerdfeger and Weagant families. We are going to pool our information and see what we can work out. I'll have to live in N.Y. City Oct. 15th to end of Nov. when I go to Fla. as this house has been rented for the winter, so can't do a whole lot more this year on genealogy. Best regards to you and all the family.
