

Williamsburg August 1826

I arrived here on the 1st August 1826, from the Theological Seminary of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the State of New York, at Hartwick, for the purpose of visiting this Congregation.

I preached in Williamsburg & Esatonuck and having accepted of a call from the Evang. Lutheran Cong. in this County, I commenced my ministerial operations on the 4th October 1826.
