2) Baptized. Herman son of Mich. Sorensen & his wife
— Samuel son of Henry Skafelt & his wife

February 23rd 1834.

1) Text 1 Cor. 10. 17/. Sacramental occasion.
Dinner of the Lord's Supper.

2) Dispensed the Lord's supper, after passing
on the Friday previous delivered the
Preparatory discourse, to 35 Communicants

March 23rd 1834.

1) Matthew 26. 38/. Conduct of Christ in Gethsemane.

Baptized. Herman Martin M. Apulman - daughter of
Ester Eliza Munk - and — M. M. Apulman - being a father - Father
And her wife Margaret - being God parents. born 26 Feb 1834.

March 28th — Good Friday.

1/ Matthew 27. 33-55. Conduct of Christ on Calvary
on the 7 last words of our Saviour.

2/ Baptism on the 22^d Instant — Catharine Margaret
daughter of Conrad Fegmire & his wife Catharine
born Bush born 7th March 1834.

March 29th — Easter Sunday — Preached Funeral Sermon
on the death of that Child — and buried it. It was
aged 25 days. Repentance was the subject of
the discourse — on The Cup which my father gave
me I drink shall I not drink it?

Easter Monday — no Service — on acct of
indisposition —

April 20th — 1834.

Matthew 28. 6/. God is abundant in mercy &
the triumph of the weak is short.

Full church — and many strangers.

May 1834. Mr C. Fegmire occupied & cultivated a part
of the Church lot — namely that part near his old barn.

Preached funeral Sermon on Caroline Birknes
daughter of Joseph Birknes & his wife. 3rd Cong.
buried on his own farm.

Preached during the course of this year in Westbrook
to the Lutheran Congregation in the 4th Conception during
the winter in the Schoolhouse at Snow's Mills - and in
the summer in the Church in the 5th Conception, every
4th Sunday regularly - baptisms - married, buried &
dispensed the Holy Sacrament of the Lord's Supper, and
catechized & confirmed. This congregation is increasing
slowly but firmly.

Mentioned to the Congregation of Onabrock
that from the 1st March 1835, now next coming -
I would be obliged to resign my Office as
their pastor - on account of increasing ill-health
and debility, but that, if possible, I would come
to them, every 4 Months once - and preach for
them - and do all other ministerial duty as
the occasion might require at my hands, gratis.
2/ Assured them - that, if they continued steadfast
in the faith - God would sooner or later provi-
de them with an able Minister and that I
would do all in my power - to procure one
for them.

3/ Stated that it was my intention to proceed
in September 1835 to the N.Y. Anniversary -
where & when I would state in words and
viva voce the Status and Condition and prospects
& encouragements of this small Cong - to that
reverend body, in order thereby to induce them
to send soon a well qualified Minister for the
Post of Honour...
