Oct. 15th 1837. Service performed by Rev. Dr. [unclear]  
Text: Acts III. 59.

Theme: The Christian's confidence

in Jesus Christ.

After service, baptized one infant

Oct. 25th 1837. Sunday. Text: Heb. 2. 6.

Theme: Christ to be chastely &  
soberly.

After service, administered the  
Lord's Supper to 17 communicants.

Oct. 15th 1837. Text: Acts III. 59. Administered the  
Lord's Supper to Rev. Dr. Thayer  
in the German language. In con-  
sequence of a fall he was unable  
to be present in the forenoon.

Nov. 11. 1837. Sunday. Text: Heb. 4. 1-15.

Theme: Objections & Encour-  
agements for laboring the Rev.

Dec. 9th 1837. Saturday. 4th. 4th.

Theme - Necessity of a preparation for heaven.
