The Interim by the Rev N. Mayhew

Feb^y 10th - Friday afternoon dispensed the holy Sacrament of the Lord's Supper to the following 2 sick persons on the Front or 1st Conception of Williamsburgh, namely to Mrs Elizabeth Markley the widow of Henry Markley & to Mrs Raimond Markley, the widow of Michael Markley. Both appeared to be very penitent & resigned.

On the 11th March, preached a Funeral sermon in St John's Church over the corpse of Mrs A. Calhoun. vide Record of Sermons 1840. & buried in St John's Churchyard. - Bad weather & much snow. Published that the Rev^d W. Martineau intended to return and encouraged the Cong. to give him a hearty welcome, as God had been pleased to answer our prayers to secure for us a Pastor.

On the 22^d December 1842, dispensed the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper to Mrs Eliza Campbell, wife of Mr. Will. Campbell at Santa Rosa, Bonabrick. She was very penitent, firm in her reliance on J. C. and ready to leave earth & earthly things.

I had invitations to preach in Bonabrick and Winchester but regret that my feeble health and other domestic relations prevented me to accept of these invitations, for the present.

I did not dispense the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper to the Lutherans in Williamsburgh, because no one of them requested me to do so. This is to be much regretted.
